EDUCATION

United Way of Greater Lafayette is working at critical points along the school spectrum to help children achieve their potential through education. We're engaging the community to support youth by volunteering for programs like Read to Succeed, and mobilizing resources to improve access to quality, affordable child care and early learning opportunities at agencies like Right Steps Child Development Centers and Head Start supported by Bauer Family Resources. When quality preschool is not an option for a family, United Way is able to help bridge the gap and be sure children enter school ready to succeed with Kindergarten Countdown Camp.

INCOME

Your United Way is helping families become stable and financially independent by supporting basic needs and promoting financial literacy. In cooperation with agencies like Food Finders Food Bank, Meals on Wheels, and Lafayette Transitional Housing, we are helping to provide for basic needs by addressing hunger, safety and housing. Organizations like Lafayette Adult Resource Academy, we are helping people obtain job training and family sustaining wages. Programs like Assets for Independence provide financial education along with a matched savings account which helps hardworking people budget and save for their education or the purchase of their first home.

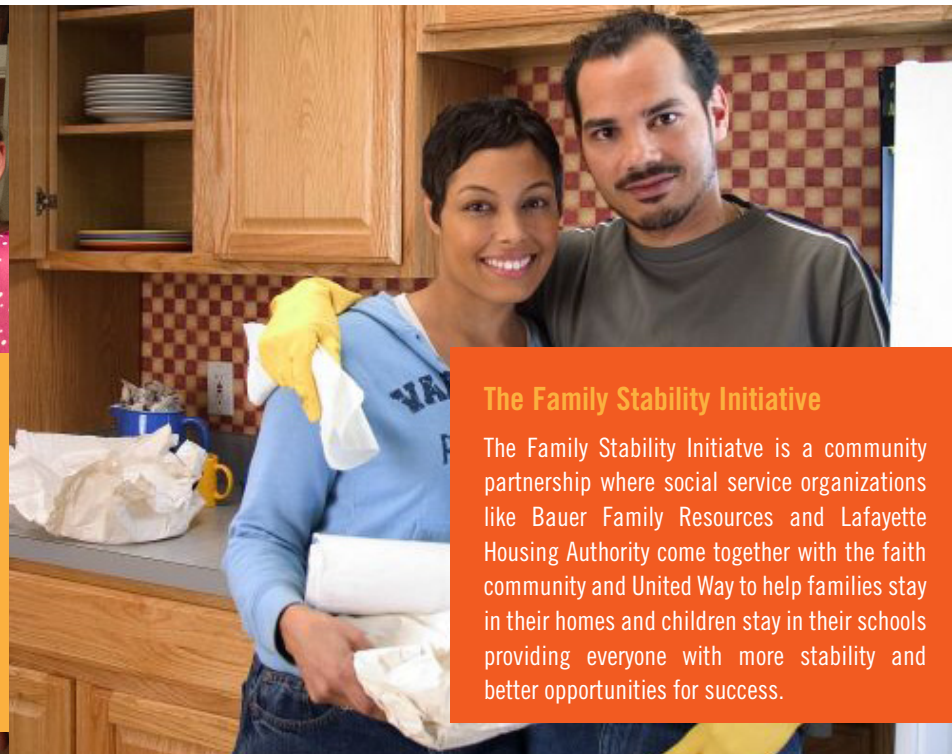
HEALTH

We're helping people in our community improve their health by providing access to health care services and promoting healthy lifestyles. The YWCA provides life-saving screenings and treatment to their patients through their Women's Cancer Program. Organizations like the Lafayette Family YMCA offer many opportunities for youth and families in our community to make healthy choices and embrace an active lifestyle. United Way is supporting Healthy Active Tippecanoe (HAT), a group that consists of many health and human service organizations and businesses in Greater Lafayette who are working together to improve childhood nutrition and physical activity in our community.



Kindergarten Countdown Camp

This summer nearly 180 incoming Kindergarten students participated in United Way's Kindergarten Countdown Camp. Last year, campers improved their literacy skills by thirty percent on the Get Ready to Read assessment. Just as important, students are learning how to succeed at school while learning to be leaders in their classrooms.



The Family Stability Initiative

The Family Stability Initiative is a community partnership where social service organizations like Bauer Family Resources and Lafayette Housing Authority come together with the faith community and United Way to help families stay in their homes and children stay in their schools providing everyone with more stability and better opportunities for success.



Prenatal Care

Thirty percent of babies born in Tippecanoe County are born to mothers who received prenatal care at Riggs Community Health Center. Prenatal care ensures a healthy pregnancy for mom and baby and also helps our newest community members have the best start possible in Greater Lafayette and Tippecanoe County.
